

Education Committee

The Education Committee has general oversight and planning responsibility for the strategic direction and development of NAHSE's educational programs. Its principal functions are:

1. To provide advice on the coordination of the educational plans and programs of NAHSE, with the programs of University Graduate Programs, the American Hospital Association, the Public Hospital Association, the American College of Healthcare Executives and other appropriate programs, departments, agencies, and activities involved in continuing education as it relates to NAHSE members and supporters of NAHSE;
2. To evaluate the educational programs of NAHSE for future planning purposes.
3. To review, evaluate, and initiate suggestions pertaining to the educational needs and/or requirements in the health field that are appropriate for consideration in the many programs offered by NAHSE; and
4. To prepare an annual report of observations, accomplishments, and recommendations to be submitted to the Executive Committee.
